NetJets Share

When you purchase a NetJets Share, you acquire an undivided interest in a specific serial-numbered aircraft. A NetJets Share is ideal for those who fly 50 or more hours per year and prefer the benefits of owning the asset. The commitment level ranges from 2 to 5 years.

NetJets Lease

When you purchase a NetJets Lease, you lease time on a specific serial-numbered aircraft. You enjoy the same access to NetJets as a NetJets Share Owner, but you do not own the asset. A NetJets Lease is ideal for those who fly 50 or more hours per year and do not want an initial capital outlay. The commitment level ranges from 2 to 5 years.

Jet Card Programs

NetJets offers jet card programs in both the United States and Europe – the Marquis Jet Card® (available in the United States) and the Private Jet Card (available in Europe). When you purchase a jet card, you access NetJets worldwide fleet – 25 hours at a time with one simple, upfront payment³. The jet card programs are ideal for those who fly 50 or fewer hours per year, prefer a short-term commitment, or simply want to experience NetJets. The Marquis Jet Card and NetJets Europe Private Jet Card are available in different commitment levels (25 hours for 1 year; 50 hours for 2 years) and also in various aircraft type combinations.

NetJets has an affiliation with the provider of the NetJets Middle East Program. Marquis Jet® Partners, Inc. is a wholly owned subsidiary of NetJets Inc. and sells the Marquis Jet Card®. Marquis Jet Card flights are operated by NetJets Aviation under its 14 CFR Part 135 Air Carrier Certificate.

NETJETS HISTORY

1964: NetJets Inc. (formerly Executive Jet, Inc.) is founded as the first private business jet charter and aircraft management company in the world with a fleet of ten aircraft.

1986: NetJets creates the concept of fractional aircraft ownership with the launch of the NetJets Fractional Aircraft Ownership Program.

1995: NetJets International and the Gulfstream Program are launched.

1996: NetJets Europe is launched.

1998: Berkshire Hathaway, Inc. purchases NetJets Inc. three and one half years after Warren Buffett buys his first NetJets share.

1999: NetJets Middle East is launched.

2001: NetJets is now available 25 hours at a time via the introduction of the Marquis Jet Card.

2007: NetJets announces the most comprehensive Ferry Waiver Program in the industry.

2010: NetJets begins installation of Wi-Fi on more than 250 aircraft with plans to equip all new aircraft that enter the NetJets fleet.

2010: NetJets announces the acquisition of Marquis Jet.

2010: NetJets Direct Financing™ is launched.

2010: NetJets announces purchase agreement with Embraer for 125 Phenom 300 Platinum Edition aircraft with delivery to begin in 2013.

2011: NetJets announces purchase agreement with Bombardier Aerospace to add up to a combined 120 new Bombardier Global aircraft into the NetJets fleet with delivery to begin in 2012.
